

Match 4 Lucks Lane 24th April 2022

On a rather lovely sunny spring day Lucks Lane proved quite a tough nut to crack.

The fishery looked really good having been closed for a few years for updating and expansion looked very nice.

The results proved that the lake fished in 3 distinct ways and this proved quite frustrating for several members.

The end bank fished well with the wind into it, both anglers at this end had a very good days fishing (Mark and Terry W) while the left hand bank struggled to put together a run of fish while the right hand bank suffered even more so.

It was a test of angling abilities and made you think.....

Winner on the day was in-form Andrew Williams who ended up with 95lb of carp on the pole from the left hand bank and was followed by Terry Williamson from the end bank with 86lb of the same.

Most anglers caught on the pole or method on a variety of baits and at the weigh in there were one or two surprises - Bob Edwards having 2 Bream at approx 4lb apiece and myself having a 5lb Grass Carp - 1st one I have ever caught.

Next outing is at Arrans in sunny ESSEX, make sure you have several nets and that you know the rules before fishing.
