A lot of these fish are showing mouth damage to a bad way where a carp I had of about 5lb could probably only get a double maggot in its mouth.....such a shame.....

Winner on the day was “end peg/Golden Child” Mason who drew his usual end peg where the wind was blowing into the corner – he fished very hard for 70lb and not only won his section/the match/the super £5 pool but also the Golden Peg monies.....
